

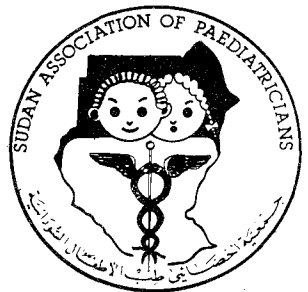

### Types of sessions:

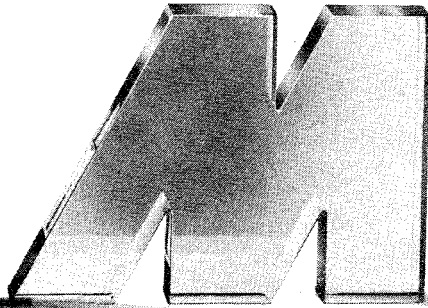

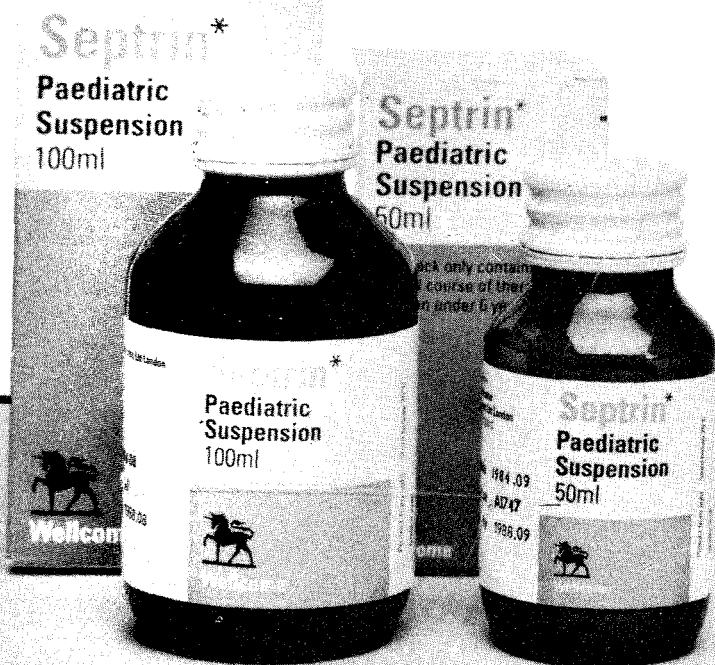
